09:00 – 10:30 **Working session 3: Gender equality: an essential condition for achieving the 17 Sustainable Development Goals**

Parliaments have a key role in the adoption and the implementation of legislative frameworks and national strategies to promote gender equality, which is a prerequisite and an accelerator for the achievement of all SDGs.
