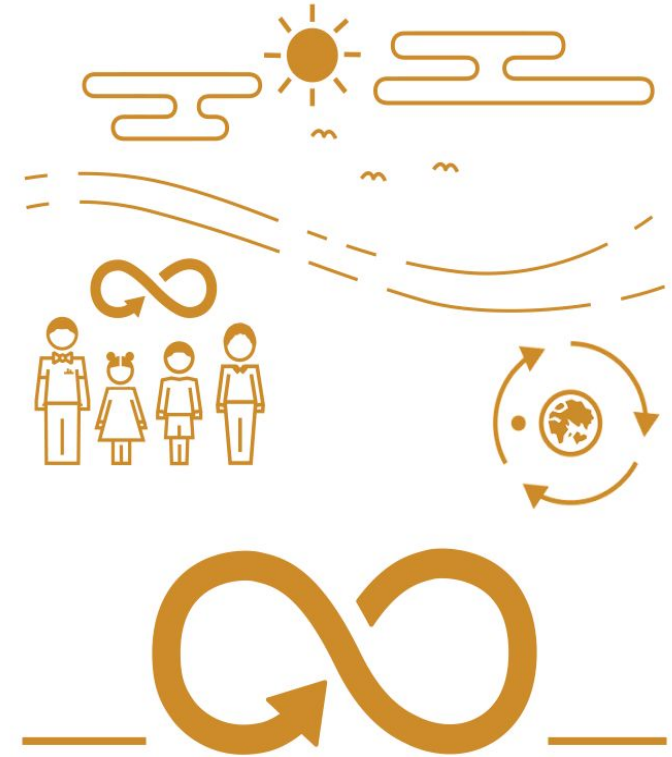

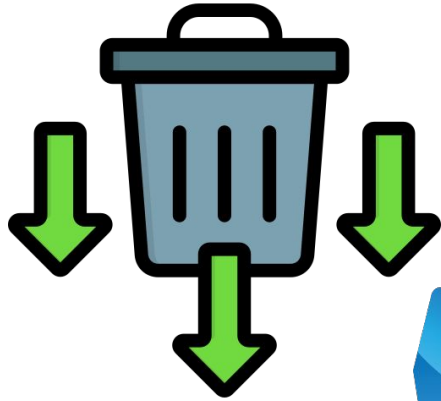

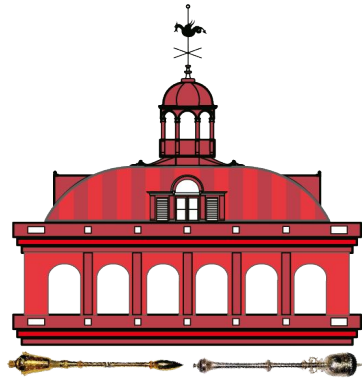

Waste Reduction Efforts - Office of the Parliament

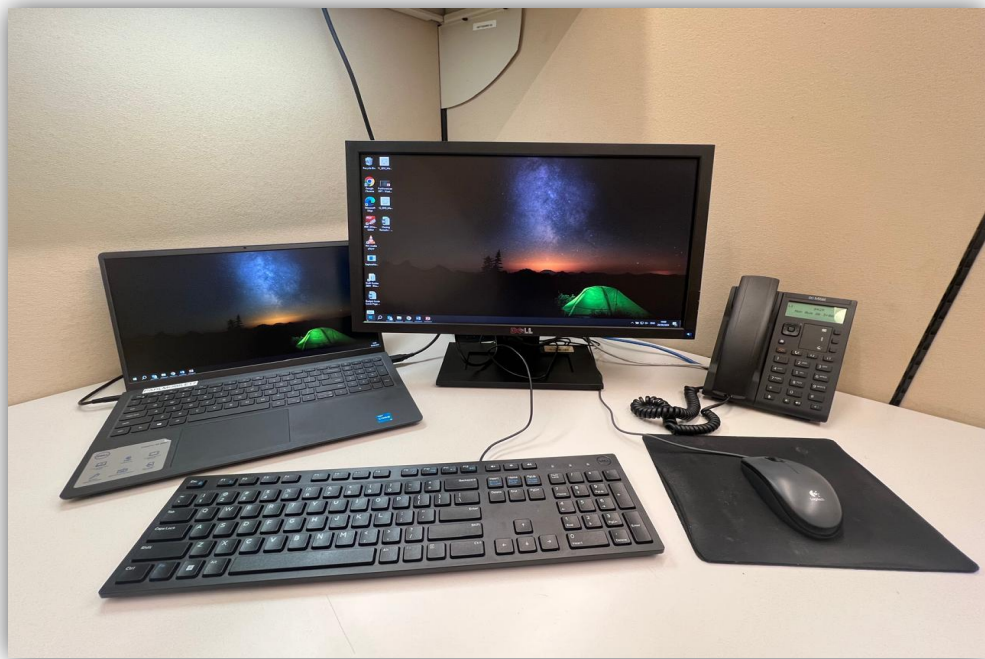
