# The Escazú Agreement and ACE: Strengthening environmental democracy in Latin America and the Caribbean

This event, taking place in the framework of COP28, will examine the importance and the manner in which parliaments can support the implementation of both the Escazú Agreement and Action for Climate Empowerment (ACE) to strengthen gender-transformative environmental democracy and ultimately meet the goals of the Paris Agreement.

ACE, the term adopted to refer to Article 6 of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and Article 12 of the Paris Agreement, calls for the empowerment of all members of society in understanding and engaging in inclusive climate action through education, training, public awareness, public participation, public access to information, and international cooperation on these issues. Similarly, the Escazú Agreement, the regional agreement for Latin America and the Caribbean, recognizes, protects, and promotes the rights of access to information, participation, and justice for all human rights defenders in environmental matters. Both mechanisms acknowledge the critical role of non-governmental actors, including women and girls, Indigenous groups, and traditionally marginalized communities in enabling effective and inclusive climate action and related decision making, in which parliaments are instrumental allies.
