The <u>Lima Commitment</u> placed special emphasis on democratic governance against corruption and reached agreements on public policy to promote transparency and public integrity in the countries of the hemisphere. ParlAmericas and the Congress of the Republic of Peru hosted the <u>official parliamentary meeting</u> of the VIII Summit of the Americas, where legislators from 25 countries highlighted legislative openness as a strategy to counter
