

SDGs and Political Participation




- Target 5: Ensure women's full and effective participation and equal opportunities for leadership at all levels of decisionmaking in political, economic and public life
- Target 9: Adopt and strengthen sound policies and enforceable legislation for the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls at all levels
- On average, 22% of ministerial portfolios/ cabinet positions in the Anglophone Caribbean are held by women.
- Across the region, women generally do not hold more than 30% of elected positions with the exception of Guyana (which has a legislated quota of one-third of the number of political party nominees must be women) and Trinidad and Tobago.


People here accept the need for women in politics and political leadership




Which sex is better suited to politics?
