### Journalists & Media

Avoid sexist language and imagery, negative adjectives, and stereotypes in media coverage of women politicians.

> Seek the opinions of women and men politicians in equal proportions in news and information spaces.

Develop and adopt **guidelines** on equal media treatment free of gender stereotypes.

Apply the principle of reversibility, omitting references to the **private lives, physical appearances, or dress** of women politicians when these would not be mentioned for men.



**Disseminate** women politicians' perspectives on topics where men are normally consulted (economics, finance, defence).
