GUIDELINES FOR PARLIAMENTARY DIALOGUE First Efforts to Implement the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in Parliaments

Parliamentary Delegation Reports:

Each parliamentary delegation will designate a representative to present a report on their parliament's early efforts to implement the <u>SDGs</u>, and <u>SDG 16</u> in particular. Each delegation should advise ParlAmericas of the name of the delegate and submit the report that will be presented by **December 2, 2016** at <u>info@parlamericas.org</u>.

Each report should be **750 words or less** and contain the following information:

- How has the parliament structured its efforts to monitor progress towards the SDGs? (i.e. has the mandate been assigned to one committee or is it shared by sectoral committees, etc.)
- What are 1 or 2 specific actions that the parliament has undertaken to ensure the implementation of the SDGs in general? (i.e. legislation proposed/passed to meet reform requirements, awareness-raising training, coordination with statistics bodies and national oversight institutions, etc.)
- 3. What are 1 or 2 specific actions that the parliament has undertaken towards SDG 16, to ensure your parliament is effective, accountable and transparent, and to ensure responsive, inclusive, participatory and representative decision-making (including gender sensitivity)? (i.e. national open parliament plan, access to information legislation, citizen participation mechanisms, accountability strengthening mechanisms, ethical standards, lobbying regulations, etc.)

Session Format:

Designated delegates will be invited to present their delegations' report, in alphabetical order of the name of countries, starting with this host country. Each designated delegate will be given **5 minutes** to present, followed by a question and answer period.
