Visas and entry requirements:

Each participant must hold a valid passport (valid for at least six months) and is responsible for obtaining any required visas or entry documents as established by the Government of the Republic of Chile. Participants are responsible for confirming with the consular authorities of their respective countries the applicable entry and vaccination requirements for Chile and any other countries where they may have stopovers. Official hotel:

Transportation:

Please note that all travellers should arrive in Santiago, Chile. Transportation between Santiago International Airport and the official hotel in Valparaíso will be arranged and provided by the National Congress of Chile upon your arrival and departure. Health Insurance:

Participants are strongly encouraged to obtain international travel health insurance that covers any medical contingencies prior to attending the Gathering. It is recommended that those who take special medications travel with their medicines, prescriptions, and any other relevant medical documents. Participants are also encouraged to verify in advance which medical centers are covered by their insurance policy in order to respond promptly and effectively in the event of any incident. It is likewise advisable to carry an emergency card containing emergency contact information, travel medical insurance information, details regarding any illnesses, allergies, and/or medications being taken, as well as any other relevant information.

ParlAmericas will not be responsible for any financial expenses or other consequences related to the medical care of any participant.

Currency:



The national currency of Chile is the Peso Chileno and is denoted by CLP. Foreign currency exchange can be done at most banks and exchange offices located at the airport and in most shopping malls. The official exchange rate is approximately \$930 CLP per \$1 USD (US dollar).

Electricity:

In Chile, the voltage is 220V at 50Hz, and plug types C / L are used. Participants bringing devices that operate on a different voltage are advised to bring a voltage converter and the appropriate plug adapter.
