All participants are advised to obtain health insurance.

COVID-19 information:

A vaccination certificate or negative PCR test result received a maximum of 48 hours prior to travel (for non-resident travellers) is required to enter the Republic of Chile.

It is advised that you consult the current health policies related to COVID-19 in the countries where your travel itinerary requires layovers.

Currency:

The national currency of Chile is the Peso Chileno and is represented by CLP. Foreign currency exchange can be done at most banks and exchange offices located at the airport and in most shopping malls. The official exchange rate is approximately \$805 CLP per \$1 USD (US dollar).

<u>Important information:</u>

All passengers must have a valid passport. It is the responsibility of each participant to consult with the consular authorities of their respective countries regarding the requirements that apply for visas, and/or entry fees (reciprocity fee), even in countries where they may have a layover. You can consult the <u>table of fees for visas and tourist visas granted abroad.</u>

Food Restrictions:

We kindly ask that any food restrictions be communicated at the time of your registration.

Electricity:

The electricity supply in Colombia is 220 volts, 50 Hertz of alternating current. The plugs and sockets are type C / L.
