Caribbean, 51.3% are women.






Gender-differentiated impacts

Comprehensive care systems as a cornerstone of sustainable development

Buenos Aires Commitment, 2022:

Promote systemic change in the approach to migration from a gender, intersectoral, intercultural and human rights perspective to highlight the contributions made to societies by migrant, displaced, refugee and asylum-seeking women...



Recognize the role of women in migration, promote their empowerment and leadership, ensuring equal opportunities, creating **mechanisms for the response, protection and inclusion of migrant and refugee women**, and developing gender-sensitive migration and refugee policies and programs focused on human rights.



- Women and girls are <u>rights holders</u>, regardless of their migratory status and nationality
- Protection measures in accordance with <u>international</u> <u>obligations</u>
- Cross-cutting, gender-responsive and intersectoral response and prevention policies
- <u>Trafficking</u> is a <u>transnational</u> crime that requires transnational responses
- Guarantee the <u>labour rights</u> of migrant women and protect girls from labour exploitation, particularly in international care circuits
- <u>Zero tolerance</u> for corruption and complicity of public officials with traffickers and those who abuse authority, harassment and sexual exploitation
