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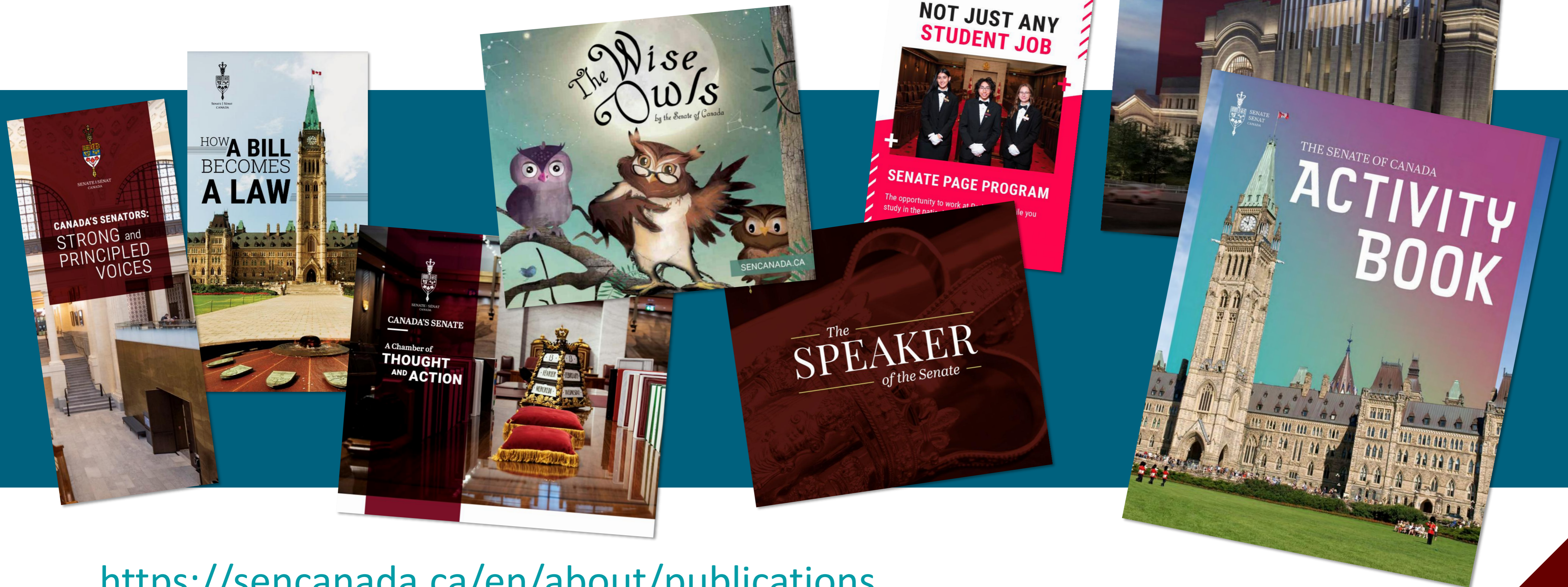




Mandate of the Communications team

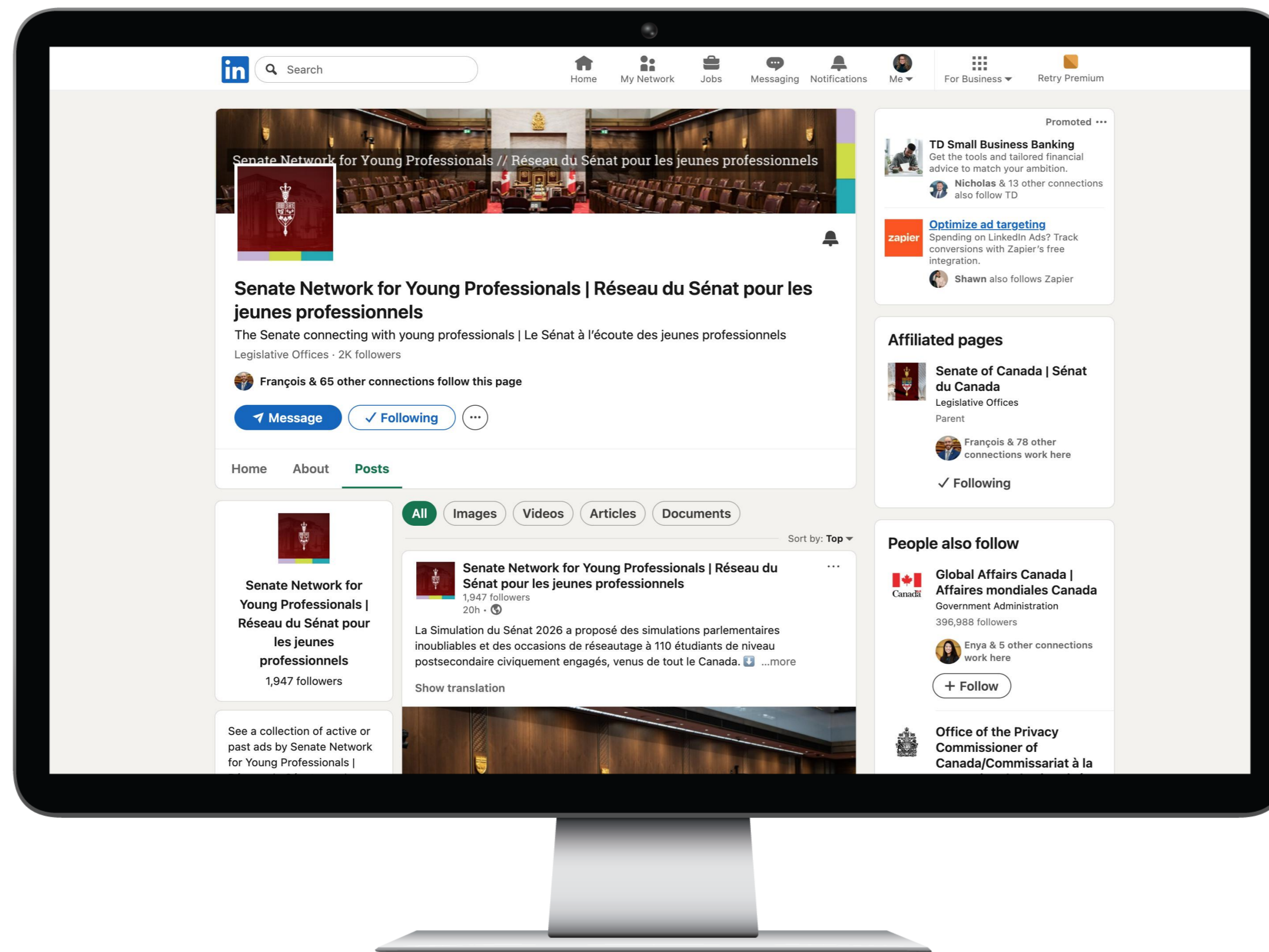
- To provide communications products and services to senators and the Senate.

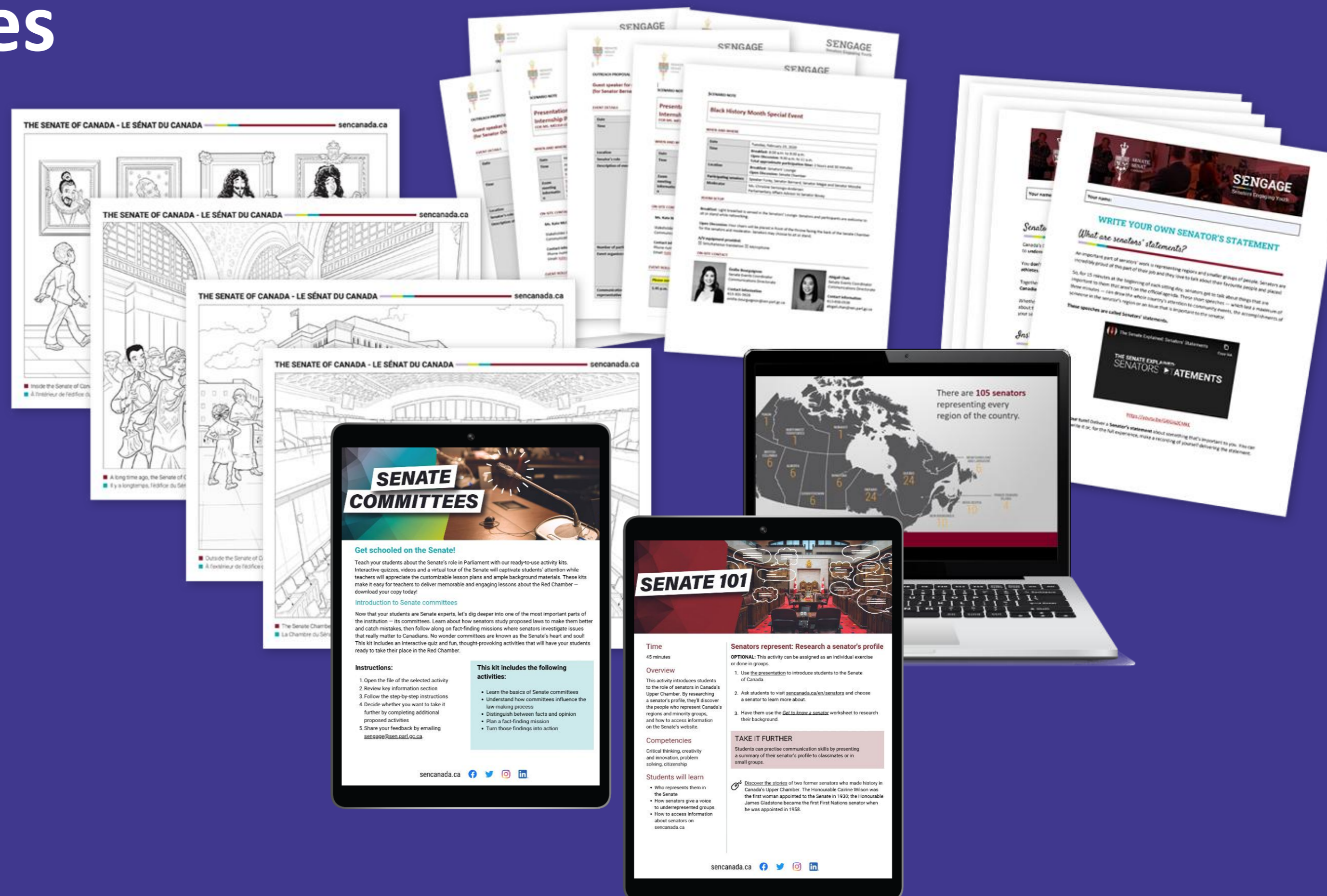

MODEL SENATE

- Model Senate is an immersive, hands-on parliamentary simulation, where students step into the roles of senators to draft legislation, participate in committee meetings and debate directly in the Senate Chamber
- During the event, participants receive career advice, gain a deeper understanding of senators' role, strengthen their knowledge of parliamentary procedure and put their public-speaking, negotiating and writing skills to the test
