



Caribbean parliamentarians and parliamentary staff participated in webinar on artificial intelligence (AI)

November 20, 2024 - The virtual workshop "[AI Tools for Parliaments](#)," part of a series of webinars for the Caribbean, took place this Wednesday, with the participation of parliamentarians and legislative staff from Caribbean countries. This session was organized in partnership with the House Democracy Partnership of the United States Congress and POPVOX Foundation.
