

Community Engagement and Outreach Strategy to Raise Awareness on Technology- Facilitated Gender- Based Violence

This sample Community Engagement and Outreach Strategy is part of the toolkit for parliamentarians and legislators informed by the findings and inputs of women parliamentarians who participated in the regional study and the meeting of Caribbean women parliamentarians on catalysing regional action on technology-facilitated gender-based violence against women¹ in public life in the Caribbean, undertaken through a collaboration between UNFPA, ECLAC and ParlAmericas. It draws upon the experiences and recommendations shared by women leaders across the region and supports evidence-informed community engagement and awareness raising efforts.

¹ For the purposes of this Checklist, the term “women” shall refer to women, girls, and adolescents, as well as any person who self-identifies as a woman in all her diversity, in accordance with Article 9 of the Belém do Pará Convention.
